

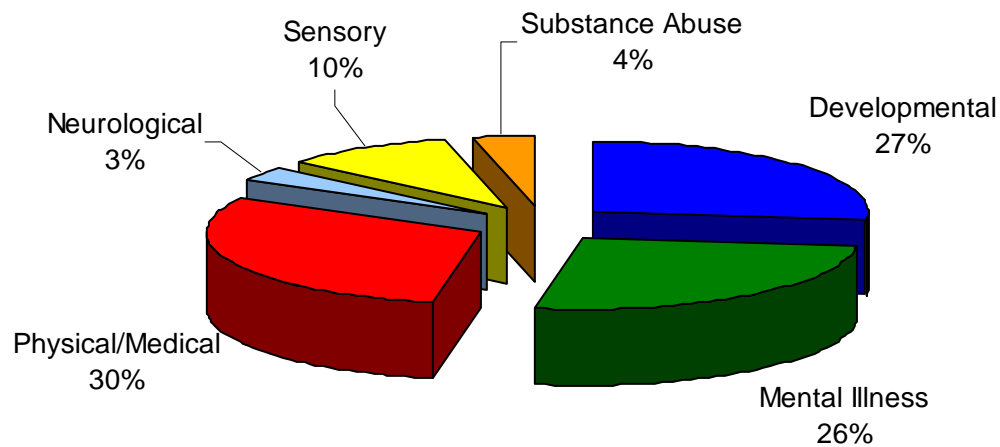
Outcomes for 2008

ServiceSource Network is comprised of four affiliate organizations: Abilities, headquartered in Florida, Employment Source, headquartered in North Carolina, OCI, headquartered in Delaware, and ServiceSource, headquartered in Virginia.



During fiscal year 2008 the ServiceSource Network:

- Served nearly 11,800 people in 10 states plus the District of Columbia
- Employed over 1,600 people as direct employees on commercial and government contracts
- Placed close to 1,196 people in community employment

(This includes all persons served and employed across the Network)

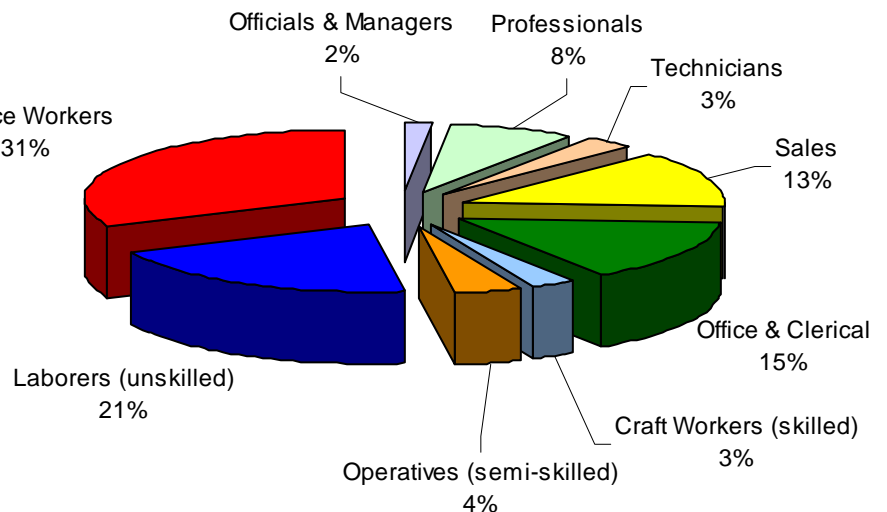
The mission of the ServiceSource Network is to provide individuals with disabilities an exceptional service delivery experience through innovative and valued employment, training, rehabilitation and support services

*Stakeholders are described as other contracted services (e.g. case management), guardians, family members, etc.





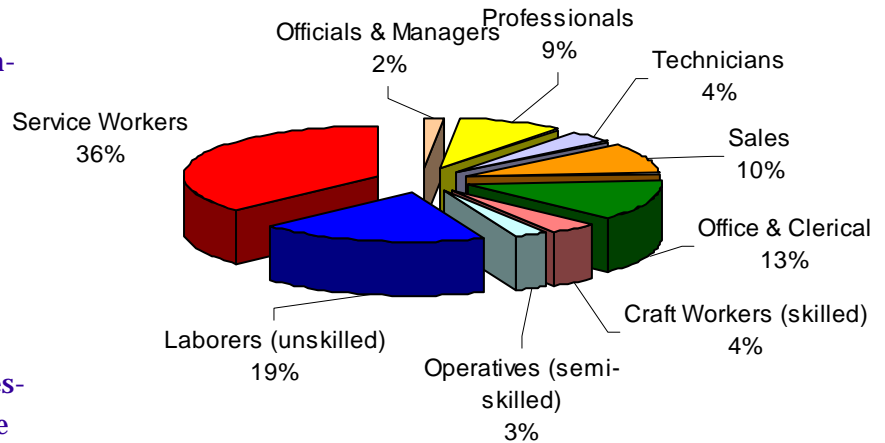
Abilities of Florida

Part of the ServiceSource Network

In FY 2008 Abilities of Florida:

- Served 9,273 individuals with disabilities
- Employed 87 people with disabilities on government or commercial contracts
- Placed 973 individuals with disabilities in competitive employment
- Provided case management for 137 Adults with Cystic Fibrosis
- 506 people were provided with affordable, accessible housing through Homes for Independence

FY08 Abilities Placements by Job Category



Abilities of Florida, established in 1959 as a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, provides vocational evaluation, accessible housing, employment and job placement services to people with disabilities throughout the State of Florida. In addition, they employ persons with disabilities for various government and commercial contracts.

- Expanded evaluations program to work with persons with brain injuries.
- Homes for Independence was awarded the Hurricane Mitigation grant for low income houses to “harden” homes against future storms. A total of 187 homes benefited from the grant and the home improvements program for FY08.
- Obtained the SSA Youth in Transition Demonstration Project grant in Miami-Dade County to assist youth in moving from school to work. This is a five year grant to serve over 400 youth.
- Obtained the AbleTrust award for \$60,000 for Veterans Employment and Outreach program.
- Transitioned to a virtual service delivery model, with staff providing employment and evaluation services in the community.
